4 Evaluation of the grounds for appeal in the principal appeal

- 4.1.1 Section 1.3 complains that the Court of Appeal applied too strict of a standard by requiring submission of exhibits that a (threatened) infringement would be made sufficiently plausible. The response to the question of legitimate interest does not depend on the merits of the asserted claim in the main action. It is sufficient for granting a claim based on Art. 843a of the Dutch Code of Civil Procedure that the legal relationship is argued with sufficient justification, according to this section.
- 4.1.2 Art. 1019a (1) of the Dutch Code of Civil Procedure provides that an obligation arising from tort due to infringement of a right to intellectual property is deemed a legal relationship as set forth in Art. 843a (1) of the Dutch Code of Civil Procedure. Art. 843a (1) of the Dutch Code of Civil Procedure provides that he has the legitimate interest thereby, can demand inspection, copying, or excerpting at his expense of specific documents relating to a legal relationship whereby he or his legal predecessors are a party from that person who has these documents at his disposal or in his custody.
