The method provided by the Accused Product involves downloading an application (the web-enabled wireless phone directly from a remote server over the internet:

Set up Fitbit Charge 3

For the best experience, use the Fitbit app for iPhones and iPads, Android phones, or Windows 10 devices. If you don't have a compatible phone or tablet, use a Bluetooth-enabled Windows 10 PC. Keep in mind that a phone is required for call, text, calendar, and smartphone app notifications.

The free Fitbit app is compatible with most iPhones and iPads, Android phones, and Windows 10 devices. If you're unsure if the Fitbit app is compatible with your device, see [fitbit.com/devices](https://www.fitbit.com/devices).

To get started:

1. Find the Fitbit app in one of the locations below, depending on your device.
 - Apple App Store for iPhones and iPads
 - Google Play Store for Android phones
 - Microsoft Store for Windows 10 devices
2. Install the app.
3. When the app is installed, open it and tap **Join Fitbit** to be guided through a series of questions that help you create an account.
4. Continue to follow the on-screen instructions to connect Charge 3 to your Fitbit account.

b. coupling the a web-enabled wireless phone to a device which provides exercise-related information;

The method provided by the Accused Product involves coupling the web-enabled wire (the Fitbit Charge 3) via “syncing,” which provides exercise-related information:

See your data in the Fitbit app

Sync Charge 3 to transfer your data to the Fitbit app, where you can view exercise and sleep data, log food and water, participate in challenges, and more. We recommend syncing at least once a day.

Each time you open the Fitbit app, Charge 3 syncs automatically when it is connected to your phone. Charge 3 also syncs with the app periodically if All-Day Sync is on. To learn more about this feature:

WHAT IS SYNCING?

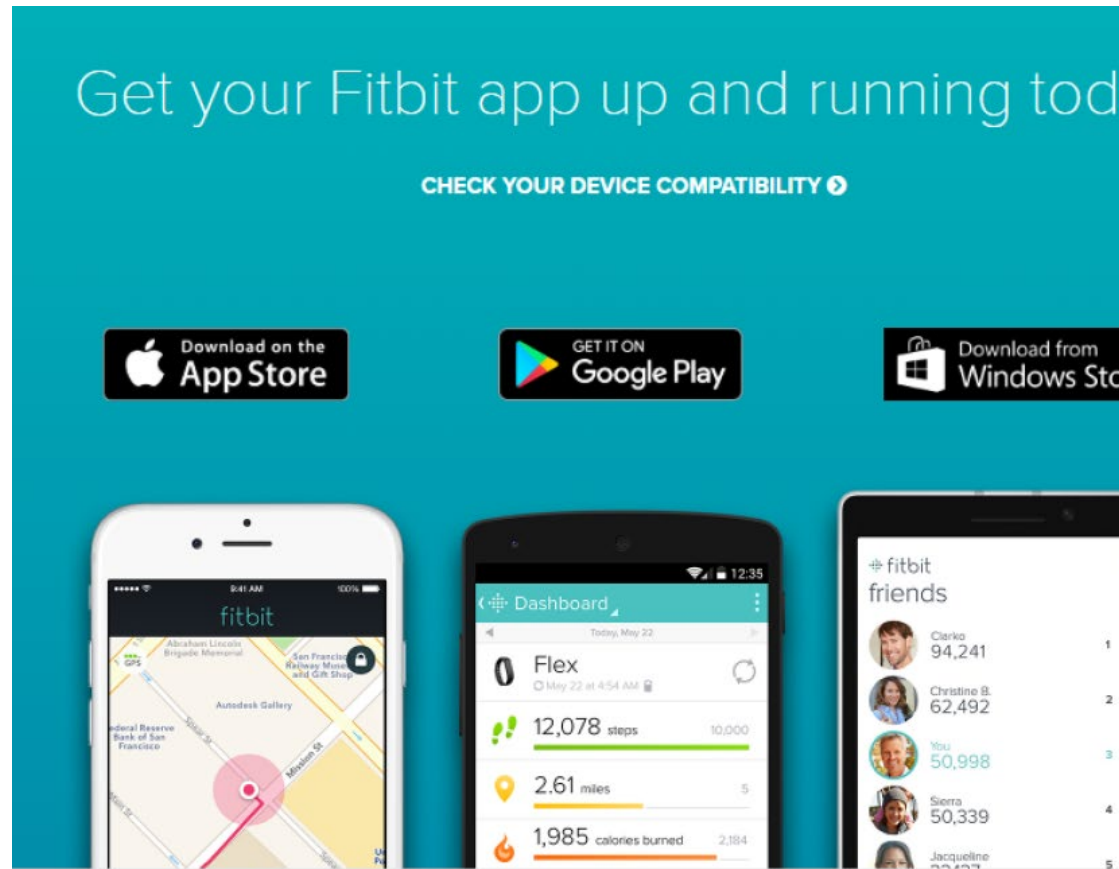
Syncing is the process that transfers the data your device collects to your Fitbit dashboard, where you can track your progress, see how you slept, set goals, log food and water, and much more. Fitbit trackers, watches, and Fitbit Aria Air use Bluetooth Low Energy (BLE) to sync with phones, tablets, and certain computers. Fitbit Aria and Fitbit Aria 2 use Wi-Fi to sync with your router. The instructions in [How do I set up my Fitbit device?](#) explain how to make sure your device syncs to your Fitbit dashboard.
