6	PLAINTIFFS' OPENING STATEMENT
7	MR. NIMROD: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen.
8	This is a case about a company, the Defendant
9	Nichia here, not playing by the rules for patents. The Court
10	played you a video yesterday that explained some of the rules
11	for patents.
12	And Everlight contends that Nichia did not play by
13	the rules when it obtained the patents and is not playing by
14	the rules in trying to assert those patents against Everlight.
15	And that is why we're here today seeking a decision from you,
16	the jury, that Nichia's patents are invalid for failure to
17	follow the rules of patents and for lacking any invention.
18	Let me reintroduce myself again. My name is Ray

Who are the parties on our side? Everlight
Electronics Company is one of the plaintiffs here. It is an
LED manufacturer located in Taiwan, and it has been making LEDs
for over 30 years. Everlight Americas is a subsidiary that
sells those LEDs in the United States.

Now, as you have heard repeatedly now, this case is about LEDs, which are light-emitting diodes, LEDs. And an LED is a type of semiconductor. A semiconductor is something that conducts electricity. An LED is a semiconductor that when you apply electricity to it, it emits light. That's why it's a light-emitting diode.

LEDs have been part of our lives for quite a while now, but more recently it's very much exploded as to how much LEDs are used. Early uses were, for example, in calculators and some of the old mobile phones, with little green and red LEDs.
