- (b) pursuant to Judiciary Law §§ 750(a) and 751, holding Defendant and its counsel in criminal contempt of the Court for their willful disobedience of Judge Ellen M. Spodek's Order, dated August 8, 2018 and Judge Paul Wooten's Order, dated September 26, 2018, together with costs and damages sustained by Plaintiff by reason of Defendant's failure to comply with the Orders;
- (c) pursuant to CPLR § 2221(a), modifying Judge Paul Wooten's Order, dated September 26, 2018;
- (d) pursuant to CPLR § 3124, compelling Defendant to respond to (1) Plaintiff's First Notice of Discovery and Inspection, dated December 8, 2018, (2) Plaintiff's First Set of Interrogatories, dated December 8, 2018, and (3) Plaintiff's Notice to Admit, dated December 8, 2018; and
- (e) granting such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper, including costs and attorney fees incurred in making this motion; and it is

ORDERED that Defendant must immediately disclose to Plaintiff (1) the time, date, and location of the closing of the sale of the Property located at Block 3642, Lot 1 in Kings County, and commonly known as 738 Chester Street, 723 Bristol Street, and 9829 Ditmas Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11236 (the "Property"), (2) the purchase price of the Property, and (3) the contact information for both the buyer's and seller's attorney conducting the closing of the sale of the Property; and it is further
