Accordingly, it is ORDERED that

- 1 On or before 12/23/2019, the plaintiff (a) to respond to TBTA's Demand For Authorizations dated 11/14/2019, and (b) to provide all parties with a new IRS authorization for the release of the plaintiff's tax returns for 2010-2018 because IRS authorization provided before last conference was returned by the IRS without the tax records.
2 On or before 12/23/2019, TBTA to exchange neuro IME report.
3 TBTA may move by OTSC returnable on 1/16/2020 to the extent a motion is needed to compel Midtown Imaging's compliance with non-party subpoena.



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Absent good cause shown, any discovery issues not raised herein will be deemed waived. All dispositive motions must be filed within 60 days of the note of issue.

Failure to comply with these directives may result in the imposition of costs or sanctions including dismissal or default judgment. Dates set forth may not be extended or adjourned except with advance approval of the Court.
