- 1. I am the attorney for Thomas Philip, , and I am fully familiar with the facts and circumstances of this matter based upon the case files maintained by this office. I submit this Order to Show Cause on behalf of GREY & GREY LLC., seeking pursuant to CPLR 321(b)(2) to be relieved as Counsel.
- 2. This action was originally commenced in Supreme Court Queens County by means of a summons and complaint, exhibit "A".
- 3. The Summons and Complaint was served on both of the Defendants, HILO MATERIAL HOLDING GROUP (HILO), and MITSUBISHI CATERPILLAR FORKLIFT AMERICA, INC., (MITSUBISHI) pursuant to 307 BCL, exhibit "B".
