If you have applied for emergency rental assistance, you may be protected from eviction for nonpayment of rent as long as your application is pending with the rental assistance provider.

To qualify for this protection, you must give your landlord documentation of your rental assistance application at or before your first appearance in court, and no later than June 30, 2022.

The protection from eviction for nonpayment of rent applies until your application is no longer pending, but no later than **September 30, 2022.**

DO NOT MISS AN EVICTION COURT DATE, even if you believe your eviction should not be moving forward. Documentation of your application for rental assistance can be provided by any reasonable method, including by sending a copy or photograph of the documentation to your landlord by email or text message. "Documentation" includes email, a screenshot, or other written or electronic documentation verifying the submission of an application for emergency rental assistance.
