10 BY MR. YOCHES:

11 Q. Good afternoon, Mr. Yourdon.

12 A. Good afternoon.

13 Q. I know you know what a deposition is, so
14 why don't we just jump right into the middle of it,
15 unless you've got any questions. This deposition will
16 be just like the other deposition that you gave in
17 this case, so same rules.

18 Now, what I'd like to do is hand you a
19 document --
