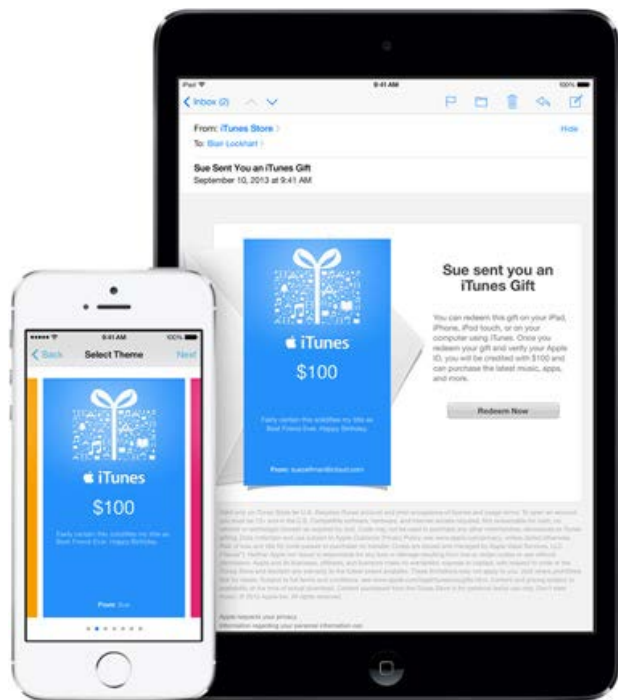
How to Redeem iTunes Gift Cards
