1. Claims 1-4 are pending. Claim 1, has been amended in this communication filed 10/14/10 entered as Amendment with RCE.

- 2. The IDS file 12/13/10 has been considered and entered.
- 2. The 35 USC 112, Second Paragraph Rejections for claims 1-4 have been overcome by the Applicant's reference to sections and pages in the Specification where the subject matter is found and the 35 USC 112, Second paragraph rejections are hereby withdrawn.

Continued Examination Under 37 CFR 1.114

A request for continued examination under 37 CFR 1.114, including the fee set forth in 37 CFR 1.17(e), was filed in this application after final rejection. Since this application is eligible for continued examination under 37 CFR 1.114, and the fee set forth in 37 CFR 1.17(e) has been timely paid, the finality of the previous Office action has been withdrawn pursuant to 37 CFR 1.114. Applicant's submission filed on 10/28/10 has been entered.

Claims 1-4 are allowed.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The closest prior art Amburn, Gatto, and Li et al. disclosed or suggested the features of a system which provides for stocks to be bought and sold automatically in a transaction and providing a confirmation by a market computer upon the actual transaction being completed. Neither Amburn or Gatto or Li et al. disclose causing in a real-time
