### Word Origin & History

ticket 1520s, "short note or document," from an aphetic form of M.Fr. *etiquet* "label, note," from O.Fr. *estiquette* "a little note" (late 14c.), especially one affixed to a gate or wall as a public notice, from *estiquer* "to affix, stick," from Frank. *\*stikkan*, cognate with O.E. *stician* "to pierce" (see *stick* (v.)). Meaning "card or piece of paper that gives its holder a right or privilege" is first recorded 1673, probably developing from the sense of "certificate, license, permit." The political sense of "list of candidates put forward by a faction" has been used in Amer.Eng. since 1711. The verb ...
