STIPULATION TO EXTEND DUE DATES

Petitioner Compass Bank, Discover Financial Services, Discover Bank, Discover Products Inc., and State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company (collectively “Petitioner”), and Patent Owner Maxim Integrated Products, Inc. (collectively “the Parties”), by and through their counsel of record, stipulate as follows:

1. On September 22, 2015, October 2, 2015, and October 7, 2015, respectively, the Patent Trial and Appeal Board issued a Case Management and Scheduling Order (“Scheduling Orders”) in each of the three related Covered Business Method Patent Reviews of Patent Nos. 5,940,510 (Case CBM2015-00098), 6,104,013 (Case CBM2015-00101) and 6,237,095 (Case CBM2015-00102), respectively. Each of these three Scheduling Orders sets the same “due dates for the parties to take action after institution” in these three related cases.

3. Each Scheduling Order states “parties may stipulate to different dates for DUE DATES 1 through 5 (earlier or later, but no later than DUE DATE 6).”

3. The Parties have stipulated to different dates for DUE DATES 1 and 2 in these three cases. The following table provides the stipulated date modifications:

| | Original DUE DATE | New DUE DATE |
|------------|-------------------|------------------|
| DUE DATE 1 | December 23, 2015 | January 13, 2016 |
| DUE DATE 2 | March 23, 2016 | April 13, 2016 |

In each of these three cases, the tasks corresponding to the above DUE DATES listed in the Scheduling Order remain unchanged. Further, DUE DATES 3-7 remain unchanged.

This stipulation is being filed simultaneously in substantially identical form in each of these three related cases CBM2015-00098, CBM2015-00101 and CBM2015-00102.
