#### STIPULATION TO EXTEND DUE DATES

(collectively "the Parties"), by and through their counsel of record, stipulate as follows:

- 1. On September 22, 2015, October 2, 2015, and October 7, 2015, respectively, the Patent Trial and Appeal Board issued a Case Management and Scheduling Order ("Scheduling Orders") in each of the three related Covered Business Method Patent Reviews of Patent Nos. 5,940,510 (Case CBM2015-00098), 6,104,013 (Case CBM2015-00101) and 6,237,095 (Case CBM2015-00102), respectively. Each of these three Scheduling Orders sets the same "due dates for the parties to take action after institution" in these three related cases.
- 3. Each Scheduling Order states "parties may stipulate to different dates for DUE DATES 1 through 5 (earlier or later, but no later than DUE DATE 6)."
- 3. The Parties have stipulated to different dates for DUE DATES 1 and 2 in these three cases. The following table provides the stipulated date modifications:

DUE DATE 1	December 23, 2015	January 13, 2016
DUE DATE 2	March 23, 2016	April 13, 2016



In each of these three cases, the tasks corresponding to the above DUE DATES listed in the Scheduling Order remain unchanged. Further, DUE DATES 3-7 remain unchanged.

This stipulation is being filed simultaneously in substantially identical form in each of these three related cases CBM2015-00098, CBM2015-00101 and CBM2015-00102.
