**SECOND STIPULATION TO EXTEND DUE DATES**

Petitioner State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company and Patent Owner Maxim Integrated Products, Inc. (collectively “the Parties”), by and through their counsel of record, stipulate as follows:

1. On September 22, 2015, October 2, 2015, and October 7, 2015, respectively, the Patent Trial and Appeal Board issued a Case Management and Scheduling Order (“Scheduling Orders”) in each of the three related Covered Business Method Patent Reviews of Patent Nos. 5,940,510 (Case CBM2015-00098), 6,104,013 (Case CBM2015-00101) and 6,237,095 (Case CBM2015-00102), respectively. Each of these three Scheduling Orders sets the same “due dates for the parties to take action after institution” in these three related cases.

3. Each Scheduling Order states “parties may stipulate to different dates for DUE DATES 1 through 5 (earlier or later, but no later than DUE DATE 6).”

3. On November 24, 2015, the Parties stipulated to different dates for DUE DATES 1 and 2 in these cases (Papers 34, 33 & 32 respectively); see below.

4. In this Second Stipulation, the Parties hereby stipulate to modified dates for DUE DATES 1 and 2 in the three cases as set forth in the following table:

	Original DUE DATE	1 <sup>st</sup> Stipulated New DUE DATE	2 <sup>nd</sup> Stipulated New DUE DATE
DUE DATE 1	December 23, 2015	January 13, 2016	January 30, 2016
DUE DATE 2	March 23, 2016	April 13, 2016	April 30, 2016

In each of these three cases, the tasks corresponding to the above DUE DATES listed in the Scheduling Order remain unchanged. Further, DUE DATES 3-7 remain unchanged.

This stipulation is being filed simultaneously in substantially identical form in each of these three related cases CBM2015-00098, CBM2015-00101 and CBM2015-00102.
