MR. RODKEY: Yes, Your Honor, that's right. What happened was the District Court order limited production in the District Court, including three depositions, the last of which is going on right now, to gather evidence of secondary considerations for use in these PTAB proceedings. The Board also recognized that relevance.

We obtained most of the productions from TradeStation at the end of last week and we've been reviewing the documents. We've been deposing the witnesses as expected and we sent a list of documents identified by Bates number and also requests to use the deposition transcripts and also to get production of certain databases and other information that came to light during the depositions for use here.

The reason we can't just simply use them is most of them are under the protective order in the District Court and because of that we can't bring them directly into the PTAB proceeding. I believe there was a motion filed in the District Court action, but that hasn't been acted on.

So we need Petitioners' agreement to
