1 THE VIDEOGRAPHER: We are now on the
2 record.

3 This is the video operator speaking,
4 Robert Calvert, of LegaLink Action Video, offices
5 located at 420 Lexington Avenue, New York, New
6 York. Today's date is April 7, 2005. The time
7 on the video monitor is 9:49 a.m.

8 We are here at the offices of Winston
9 & Strawn, located at 200 Park Avenue, New York,
10 New York, to take the videotape deposition of
11 Robert McCausland, in the matter of Trading
12 Technologies, Incorporated, versus eSpeed,
13 Incorporated. The venue of this case is the
14 United States District Court for the Northern
15 District of Illinois. The index number is
16 04-CV-5312.

17 Will counsel please voice identify
18 yourselves and state whom you represent.

19 MR. PERKINS: Good morning. Ray
20 Perkins, representing the defendant, eSpeed.

21 MR. ZILBERBERG: David Zilberberg,
22 representing the witness, Robert McCausland.

23 MR. SAMPSON: Matt Sampson from
24 McDonnell Boehnen Hulbert & Berghoff,

2 Technologies. With me today is Steven Borsand
3 from Trading Technologies, and Patrick Catania,
4 an independent consultant.

5 THE VIDEOGRAPHER: Will the court
6 reporter please swear in the witness.

7 R O B E R T G. M c C A U S L A N D,
8 having been first duly sworn by the Notary Public
9 (Jack Finz), was examined and testified as
10 follows:

11 THE VIDEOGRAPHER: Please begin.

12 EXAMINATION BY MR. PERKINS:

13 Q. Sir, could you please state your name
14 for the record?

15 A. Robert McCausland.

16 Q. And where do you live?

17 A. I live in Mendham, New Jersey.

18 Q. What's your street address?

19 A. 21 Pembroke Drive.

20 Q. You have been deposed before; is that
21 correct?

22 A. Yes, I have.

23 Q. About how many times?

24 A. At least three.

1 Q. How many times have you been deposed
2 regarding the Intex system?

3 A. Well, once where it was the relevant
4 system in question, yes.

5 Q. And which case was that?

6 A. That was -- I guess at that point it
7 was eSpeed versus the three commodity exchanges,
8 Board of Trade, the Chicago Merc and the New York
9 Merc.

10 Q. Do you still have a copy of that
11 deposition?

12 A. If I do, I don't know where it is.

13 Q. If at any time you do not understand
14 my questions, just let me know and I will try to
15 repeat or rephrase the question. Do you agree to
16 do that?

17 A. Yes. Thank you.
