

## 6-2 Setting the Method of Displaying Prices on Board Screens

For a board screen split into two parts, a board screen split into four parts, and a board screen split into six parts, either "Uncompressed Mode" or "Compressed Mode" can be selected as the price display mode for board information.

### 6-2-1 Price Display Modes

- ◆ Uncompressed Mode

This mode displays all prices on the board regardless of, for example, whether orders exist at any given price, or the like.

- ◆ Compressed Mode

This mode displays, from among the prices on the board [in the Uncompressed Mode], only those prices that meet the conditions below. [Translator's note: bracketed text is implied in the source Japanese text.]

- ◇ Price for which an order exists
- ◇ Latest contract price (including the current day's base price)
- ◇ Quotation display price
- ◇ Matching price

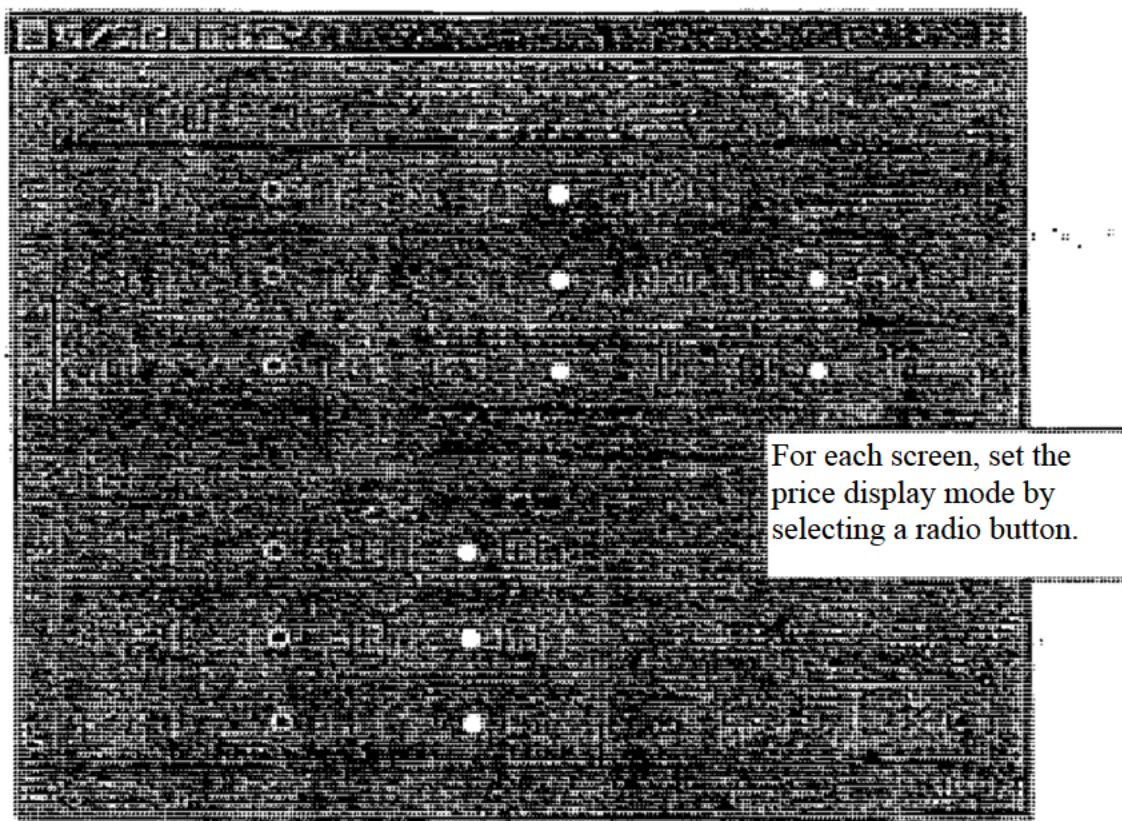

### 6-2-2 Setting Method

- ① From the Menu Bar in the Main Window, select, in order: "Settings" → "5 Board/Quotation Screen Settings."
- ② In the "Price Display Mode Settings Column" [Translator's note: Because the screenshot below is illegible, it is uncertain whether the character 欄 {ran} here refers to a field, column, row, or area.] of the "Board/Quotation Screen Settings Instruction Input Window," select the radio button of the price display mode that you wish to set for each board screen of each size.
- ③ Perform the "Send" operation to set the price display formats of the board screens.
