On April 21, 2017 a conference call was held between counsel for the parties and Judges Medley, Petravick, and Plenzler. Petitioner requested the call to seek an increase in the word count limit for the Petitioner's Reply (*see* 37 C.F.R. § 42.24(c)(1)). A transcript of the call appears as Exhibit 1083 in the record of CBM2016-00054. After consideration of the information presented during the call, the Board increased the word count limit for the Petitioner's Reply in each proceeding by 500 words, limited to addressing *Trading Technologies International, Inc., v. CQG, INC.*, No. 2016-1616, 2017 WL 192716 (Fed. Cir. Jan. 18, 2017).
