Communicating States and Security	Construction
"mobile platform"	Any mobile entity that can be tracked or have a tracking device installed or attached (for example, a vehicle, a person, a portable computer, or a mobile telephone).
"remote tracking system" and "remote tracking service"	A system physically separate from the mobile platform being tracked that determines the location of the mobile platform.
"a property that is predetermined for each mobile platform"	A property of a mobile platform determined before a remote tracking system determines the location of the mobile platform.
"subscriber"	A person or company that subscribes to the location determination services.
