

APPENDIX A

CONSTRUCTION OF TERMS FOR U.S. PATENT NO. 6,771,970

Claim Term	Construction
“mobile platform”	Any mobile entity that can be tracked or have a tracking device installed or attached (for example, a vehicle, a person, a portable computer, or a mobile telephone).
“remote tracking system” and “remote tracking service”	A system physically separate from the mobile platform being tracked that determines the location of the mobile platform.
“a property that is predetermined for each mobile platform”	A property of a mobile platform determined before a remote tracking system determines the location of the mobile platform.
“subscriber”	A person or company that subscribes to the location determination services.

APPENDIX B

CONSTRUCTION OF TERMS FOR U.S. PATENT NO. 7,907,933

Claim term	Construction
“information . . . related to a user’s purchase request” and “the purchase request information”	Information related to a user's request to purchase, lease, or license a selected good or service.
“electronic communication”	A telephone call.
“first destination”	A pay-per-call number or service.
“the destination”	This term recited in claim 13 as “remote processing system associated with <i>the destination</i> ” refers back to “a first destination,” also recited in claim 13.
