Notice is hereby given, pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a), that Petitioner Microsoft Corporation (“Microsoft”) hereby appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision entered on February 19, 2014 (Paper 73) (the “Final Written Decision”).

In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), Microsoft further indicates that the issue on appeal is the Patent Trial and Appeal Board’s decision that Microsoft did not establish by a preponderance of the evidence that claim 24 is unpatentable and the findings supporting that ruling including, without limitation, its interpretation of the claim language (in claim 22) “searching for data with the same digital digest in said network cache memory.”



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
