Pursuant to the Board's February 12, 2013, Scheduling Order (Paper 16), Petitioner, Motorola Mobility LLC, respectfully requests oral argument for the trial currently scheduled on November 7, 2013. Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.70, Petitioner specifies the following issues to be argued:

- I. The proper construction of: "connector for connecting" and "wherein the readers are configured so that they will not operate with a computer other than a portable computer of the system."
- II. Whether claims 1, 3, 7, 15, 16, 18, and 20 of U.S. Patent No. 7,516,484 ("the '484 patent") are anticipated by U.S. Patent No. 5,463,742 to Kobayashi ("Kobayashi").
 - a. Among other things, whether Kobayashi discloses a "security protocol."
- III. Whether claims 1, 3, 7, 15, 16, 18, and 20 of the '484 patent are anticipated by U.S. Patent No. 5,436,857 to Nelson ("Nelson").
 - a. Among other things, whether the portable computer and the portable base unit of Nelson have a specialized design.


