**PETITIONER AVAYA INC.'S REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT**

Pursuant to the Board's Order dated November 15, 2013 (Paper 69), Petitioner Avaya Inc. ("Avaya") respectfully requests oral argument, currently scheduled for January 9, 2014. Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.70(a), Avaya intends to argue the following issues:

1. Claims 6 and 9 are unpatentable: (a) under 35 U.S.C. § 102(b) as being anticipated by Matsuno; and (b) under 35 U.S.C. § 103(a) over De Nicolo in view of Matsuno;
2. Patent Owner's Motion to Amend should be denied, and Patent Owner has failed to meet its burden demonstrating patentability of the proposed substitute claims;
3. The second declaration of Dr. Knox (Ex. N1-2024) should be excluded.

Avaya requests the ability to use audio/visual equipment to display demonstrative exhibits, including the use of a projector and screen for PowerPoint display.
