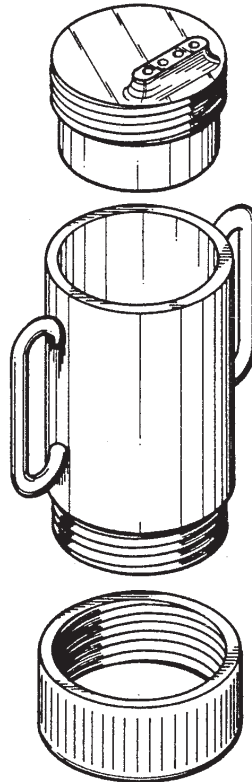

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a child's travel drinking cup, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of a child's travel drinking cup showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view, the right side elevational view being a mirror image; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view with the cap in the closed position; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 5.



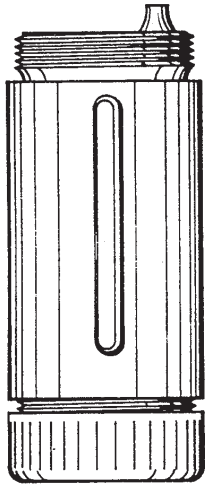

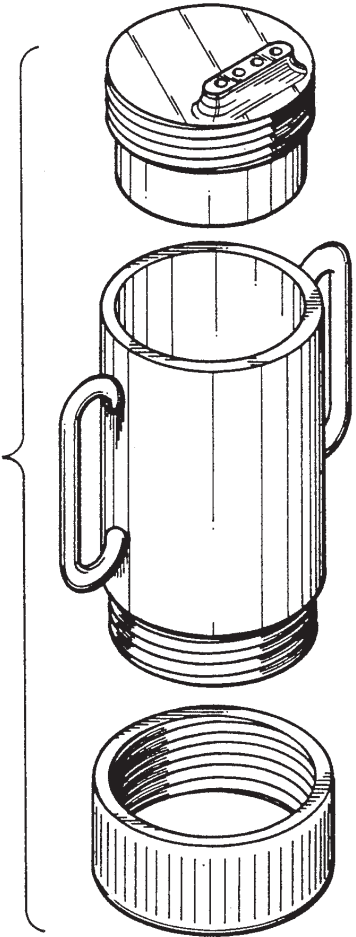

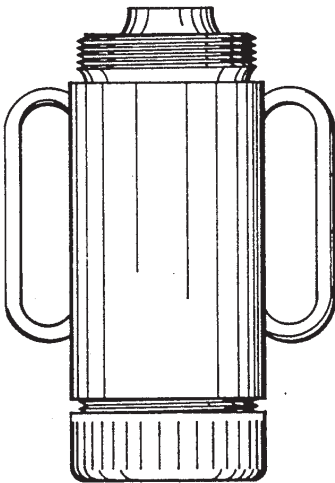

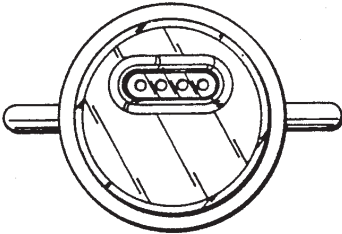

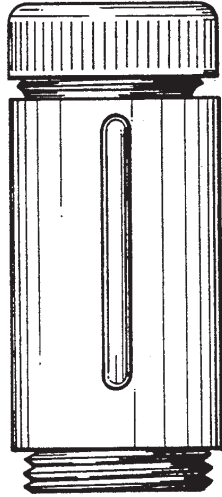

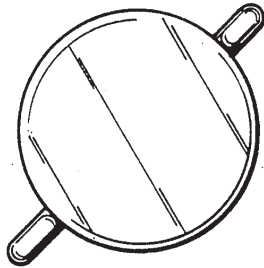

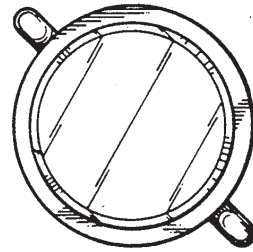
