ORDER LIFTING STAY OF CONCURRENT REEXAMINATIONS
CONDUCT OF THE PROCEEDING
37C.F.R. § 42.5

Kyocera Corporation (“Petitioner”) filed a Petition for *inter partes* review challenging claims 1, 33, 36, 43, 48, 51, 52, 58, 59, 66, 118, 138, 139, 149, 183, 252, 283, and 317 of U.S. Patent No. 7,461,353 (“the ’353 Patent”). Paper 4. On December 20, 2012, we entered an order staying co-pending reexamination proceedings 95/000,634; 90/009,994; and 95/002,132 concerning the ’353 Patent, while the *inter partes* review proceeded. Paper 10. IPR2013-00256 brought by Motorola Mobility LLC was joined to IPR2013-00007.

In a Final Written Decision entered on March 27, 2014, we determined that challenged claims 1, 33, 36, 43, 48, 51, 52, 58, 59, 66, 118, 138, 139, 149, 183, 252, 283, and 317 of the ’353 Patent were unpatentable. Paper 51.

On May 20, 2014, Softview LLC (“Patent Owner”) appealed our Final Written Decision to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit. Paper 52. On February 9, 2015, the Federal Circuit Court of Appeals entered a judgment under Fed. Cir. R. 36 affirming our Final Written Decision. *Softview LLC v. Kyocera Corp. and Motorola Mobility LLC.*, No. 2014-1600 (Fed. Cir. Feb. 9, 2015)

In e-mail correspondence on October 30, 2015, Patent Owner requested that we lift the stay of the re-examination proceedings 95/000,634; 90/009,994; and 95/002,132 concerning the ’353 Patent.

In consideration of the above it is

ORDERED that the stay of re-examination proceedings 95/000,634; 90/009,994; and 95/002,132 is lifted.
