Conduct of the Proceeding

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The Board conducted a conference call with the parties on October 11, 2013, to discuss Cyanotech's request for leave to file a reply to the University's patent owner preliminary response. Cyanotech argued that the case presents a question of first impression concerning 35 U.S.C. § 315(a) and that the University cited recent decisions that did not exist at the time Cyanotech filed its petition.

Upon consideration of Cyanotech's request, the Board determined that additional briefing prior to the decision on the petition is unnecessary.

Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that Cyanotech is not authorized to file a reply to the patent owner preliminary response.

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
