REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE


1. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: the prior art of record fails to teach the discharging step (claim 15) and the adjusting step (claim 35). In other words, there is no teaching to discharge until the end of a predetermined time period or until an electrical unit measured across the electrodes decays to a predetermined terminal level, whichever occurs first.
