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**PETITIONER ZOLL LIFECOR CORPORATION'S  
REQUEST FOR REFUND OF POST-INSTITUTION FEES**

Pursuant to the Patent and Trademark Office's Final Rule Setting and Adjusting Patent Fees, 78 Fed. Reg. 4212, 4232–4234 (Jan. 18, 2013), Petitioner Zoll Lifecor Corporation (“Petitioner”), request a refund in the amount of \$14,000.00 to be paid to deposit account number 06-1050.

On September 23, 2013, Petitioner filed a Petition for Inter Partes Review of U.S. Patent No. 5,749,905 with the Patent Trial and Appeal Board that was assigned case number IPR2013-00616.
