11 EXAMINATION BY MR. WEINBERG

12 MR. WEINBERG: Q. Good morning, Dr. Strawn.

13 A Good morning.

14 Q My name is Dan Weinberg, and I represent
15 B.E. Technology, which is the patent owner.

16 You understand you're being deposed today as
17 an expert witness; is that right?
