REPLY TO PETITIONERS' OPPOSITION TO PATENT OWNER'S

MOTION TO EXCLUDE EVIDENCE PURSUANT TO 37 C.F.R. § 42.64



On December 30, 2014, Patent Owner Arendi S.A.R.L. ("Arendi" or "Patent Owner") filed a Motion to Exclude Evidence under 37 C.F.R. §42.64(c) [herein, the "Motion"], and on January 13, 2015, Petitioners filed Petitioners' Opposition to Patent Owner's Motion to Exclude Evidence [herein, the "Petitioners' Opposition"]. The Patent Owner stands by its arguments as set forth in its motion to exclude and adds the following comments in reply to Petitioners.

The Petitioners are egregiously mistaken to argue relevance of the Menascé deposition on the basis of discussions of Domini and Hachamovitch. These references are not at issue in the present IPR. The prior art reference at issue, Pandit [US 5,859,636], was never mentioned during the deposition. Indeed, other than to identify Dr. Menascé as the declarant who filed the declaration with respect to US 7,917,843, the claims of the '843 patent being challenged in the present IPR were never discussed in the deposition. The deposition needs to be excluded as being totally irrelevant.

Moreover, 37 C.F.R. §42.123 controls the introduction of new evidence into an inter partes review. Petitioners should not be permitted to introduce late evidence through the back door by becoming a proponent of a deposition transcript in defiance of §42.123. Any testimony of the expert witness could have been included in his declaration and filed with the Petition. The requirements of 37



C.F.R. §42.123 should control regardless of whether Petitioners present late testimony in a supplemental declaration or have its expert expound in a deposition.

The transcript entirely lacks relevance to the present IPR and should be excluded under the rules of evidence and 37 C.F.R. §42.123.
