- III. Whether Claims 15, 16, and 21 are Unpatentable Under 35 U.S.C. § 103 as obvious over Diamante Owner's Manual in view of Diamante Preview Distance Control Manual.
- IV. Whether Claim 12 is Unpatentable Under 35 U.S.C. § 103 as obvious over Diamante Owner's Manual in view of Watanabe.
- V. Whether Claims 18 and 19 are Unpatentable Under 35 U.S.C. § 102 as anticipated by Watanabe.
- VI. Whether Claims 2-5, 26-28, and 34-36 are Unpatentable Under 35 U.S.C. § 102 as anticipated by Celsior.
- VII. Rebuttal to Patent Owner's presentation on all matters including the issues listed above.
