Study Design Schematic



(57) **Abstract**: Provided herein are methods for treating chronic pain by administering low doses of buprenorphine twice daily (or once daily) via a trarismucosal drug delivery device. The methods and devices efficiently treat chronic pain without significant side effects. In one embodiment, the buprenorphine delivery device comprises a bioerodable mucoadhesive layer comprising a therapeutically effective amount of buprenorphine disposed in a buffered polymeric diffusion environment, wherein the polymeric diffusion environment is a buffered environment having a pH of between about 4 and about 6.
