unsecured name	A name that can be resolved by a conventional name service	Indefinite
secure name	An authenticated name that can be resolved by a secure name service and can be used for establishing a secure communication link	Indefinite; Or, in the alternative: a name of a device that corresponds to a network address that requires authorization by the secure name service for access and that is used for establishing a secure communication link
secure communication link	A direct communication link that provides data security through encryption where direct refers to direct addressability	A virtual private network (VPN) communication link, wherein a VPN is a network of computers which privately and directly communicate with each other by encrypting traffic on insecure paths between the computers where the communication is both secure and anonymous
secure name service	A lookup service that returns a network address for a requested secure name and facilitates establishing a secure communication link based on a secure name	Indefinite; or, in the alternative: a lookup service that returns a network address for a requested secure name upon authorization
sending a message securely	transmit information with data security	Sending a message over a secure communication link
the desire[d]	Customary and ordinary meaning to a person of ordinary skill in the art - No construction necessary	Indefinite
