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**MOTION FOR WITHDRAWAL OF REPRESENTATION  
OF PATENT OWNER BY SHARON FENICK, DANIEL H. GOLUB,  
AND BRIAN P. GORDAYCHIK**

## **I. RELIEF REQUESTED**

As authorized in the Order dated May 13, 2014 (Paper No. 8), Sharon Fenick, Daniel H. Golub, and Brian P. Gordaychik respectfully file this motion to request withdrawal from further representation of Patent Owner in this proceeding under 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.116 and 42.10(e).

## **II. GOVERNING RULES**

“Counsel may not withdraw from a proceeding before the Board unless the Board authorizes such withdrawal.” 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(e). Further, 37 C.F.R. § 11.116(b)(1) provides that “[e]xcept as stated in paragraph (c) of this section, a practitioner may withdraw from representing a client if . . . [w]ithdrawal can be accomplished without material adverse effect on the interests of the client. . . .”

Paragraph (c) of this Section provides that “[a] practitioner must comply with applicable law requiring notice to or permission of a tribunal when terminating a representation. When ordered to do so by a tribunal, a practitioner shall continue representation notwithstanding good cause for terminating the representation.”

“Upon termination of representation, a practitioner shall take steps to the extent reasonably practicable to protect a client's interests. . . .” 37 C.F.R. § 11.116(d).

## **III. STATEMENT OF FACTS**

Based on the following statement of facts, Sharon Fenick, Daniel H. Golub, and Brian P. Gordaychik, as designated lead and back-up counsel on behalf of

Patent Owner in this proceeding, respectfully request authorization from the Board to withdraw from representation of Patent Owner in this proceeding.

1. Derek Wood, Secretary of the general partner, Rembrandt Virginia Management, LLC, assents to the withdrawal of Sharon Fenick, Daniel H. Golub, and Brian P. Gordaychik, as evidenced in the Power of Attorney filed on May 13, 2014, which indicates that Patent Owner desires to appoint Thomas J. Engellenner, Reza Mollaaghababa, and Lana Gladstein as its attorneys in this proceeding;
2. Sharon Fenick, a registered practitioner (Reg. No. 45,269), hereby agrees to take steps to the extent reasonably practicable to protect Patent Owner's interests;
3. Daniel H. Golub, a registered practitioner (Reg. No. 33,701), hereby agrees to take steps to the extent reasonably practicable to protect Patent Owner's interests;
4. Brian P. Gordaychik, a registered practitioner (Reg. No. 62,179), hereby agrees to take steps to the extent reasonably practicable to protect Patent Owner's interests;
5. Thomas J. Engellenner is a registered practitioner (Reg. No. 28,711);
6. Reza Mollaaghababa is a registered practitioner (Reg. No. 43,810);
7. Lana Gladstein is a registered practitioner (Reg. No. 48,502); and

8. Counsel for Petitioner has agreed not to oppose the motion.

#### **IV. WITHDRAWAL IS PERMITTED**

The facts outlined above in the Statement of Facts demonstrate that Sharon Fenick, Daniel H. Golub, and Brian P. Gordaychik are entitled to withdraw from representation in this proceeding, as such withdrawal can be accomplished without material adverse effect on the interests of the Patent Owner. The Patent Owner has assented to the termination of their representation of the Patent Owner in this proceeding, as evidenced by the Power of Attorney appointing Thomas Engellenner, Reza Mollaaghababa, and Lana Gladstein as Counsel for Patent Owner. Counsel for Petitioner has also assented to the withdrawal. Further, the withdrawal will not cause prejudice to the rights of the Patent Owner as Thomas Engellenner, Reza Mollaaghababa, and Lana Gladstein are registered practitioners and are familiar with the underlying legal and technical issues of the instant proceedings.

**V. CONCLUSION**

In light of the foregoing, it is respectfully requested that the Board grant this motion for withdrawal of representation of Patent Owner in this proceeding by Sharon Fenick, Daniel H. Golub, and Brian P. Gordaychik.
