3 JUDGE CHANG: Please be seated. This is the
4 hearing for cases IPR2014-00578 and IPR2014-00604
5 involving patent 6,896,775.

6 And the Board instituted these two Inter Partes
7 Reviews on October 15th, 2014. Subsequent to the institution
8 the Board granted a joint motion in each case joining both
9 IPR2014-01494 and IPR2014-01482. This is a combined oral
10 hearing. The transcript for this oral hearing will be entered in
11 each of the joint proceedings.

12 And consistent with the Board's previous order,
13 each party has one hour each. And Petitioner will proceed
14 first to present its case as to the challenged claims, and the
15 Petitioner may reserve rebuttal time, and thereafter the Patent
16 Owner will respond to the Petitioner's case.

17 At this time I would like the counsel to introduce
18 yourselves and your colleagues, beginning with the Petitioner.

19 MR. CAVANAUGH: This is David Cavanaugh. I
20 represent Gillette. With me is Sam Ha, also representing
21 Gillette with Wilmer Hale. Also with me is Cosmin Maier,
22 who is with Wilmer Hale representing Gillette.

23 The other Petitioners over here, David O'Dell is
24 with Haynes and Boone representing Fujitsu, David McCombs

1 also with Haynes and Boone representing Fujitsu, and Gregory
2 Huh representing Fujitsu.

3 JUDGE CHANG: Thank you.

4 MR. FAHMI: Good afternoon, Your Honors.
5 Tarek Fahmi on behalf of the Patent Owner. With me is Bruce
6 Barker.

7 JUDGE CHANG: Thank you. Counsel, do you
8 have a copy of the demonstratives for the court reporter and
9 for the Panel?

10 MR. CAVANAUGH: Yes, we do.

11 MR. FAHMI: Yes.

12 JUDGE CHANG: Okay. Great. Thank you. You
13 may proceed at any time.

14 MR. CAVANAUGH: Thank you. May it please
15 the Board. Good afternoon. I'm Dave Cavanaugh and with
16 me, as I mentioned earlier, is Cosmin Maier and Sam Ha. I
17 would like to reserve 10 minutes for rebuttal and get started.

18 So last October as, Judge Chang, you noted, the
19 Board instituted a trial on all of the claims of the '775 patent.
20 In the decision on institution the Board credited the testimony
21 of the Petitioner's expert, Mr. DeVito, and found that there
22 was a reasonable likelihood that the challenged claims were
23 unpatentable based on the combinations of references that
24 include Wang, Mozgrin, Kudryavtsev, and a few others for
25 some dependent claims.

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
