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1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 JUDGE SAINDON: Good morning. This is  
3 Judge Saindon. We're here today with a series  
4 of four cases dealing with Zimmer versus  
5 Bonutti. Before we get started I'd just like to  
6 take a quick roll call to make sure we have  
7 everyone online. We'll start with the Patent  
8 Owner.

9 MR. KAPPEL: Cary Kappel, Davidson,  
10 Davidson & Kappel for the Patent Owner.

11 JUDGE SAINDON: Okay. Petitioner?

12 MR. MODI: Good morning, Your Honor.  
13 This is Naveen Modi with Paul Hastings. I'm  
14 here for the Petitioner, and I do have one of my  
15 colleagues here, Mita Chatterjee.

16 JUDGE SAINDON: Okay. With me today are  
17 Judges Zecher and Rice. And, Mr. Modi, I  
18 understand that you have a court reporter on the  
19 line.

20 MR. MODI: Yes, Your Honor. I was  
21 actually going to mention that next. We do have  
22 a court reporter on the call.

1 JUDGE SAINDON: Okay. If you could just  
2 please file the transcript as an exhibit in each  
3 of the four cases, please.

4 MR. MODI: We will do that, Your Honor.

5 JUDGE SAINDON: All right. Petitioner,  
6 you're the one who requested this call. I  
7 understand there were two things that you  
8 mentioned you'd like to discuss. Let's -- let's  
9 hear from you first, then, as to why we are here  
10 today.

11 MR. MODI: Thank you, Your Honor. Before  
12 we do sort of get into those two issues, I just  
13 have one other housekeeping matter that I wanted  
14 to just mention for the Board's benefit. If  
15 I could start with that.

16 JUDGE SAINDON: Sure.

17 MR. MODI: So as the Board's aware, we  
18 filed new Power of Attorneys and Mandatory  
19 Notices in each of the four proceedings. And as  
20 you probably know from the record, we are now  
21 new counsel of record for Zimmer in all four  
22 IPRs. We just wanted to make sure we did not

1           need to do anything else to effectuate the  
2           change in counsel, you know, such as Motions to  
3           Withdraw. We just were not sure and we wanted  
4           to make sure we sought the Board's guidance on  
5           that issue.

6                    JUDGE SAINDON: So are you saying the  
7           prior counsel withdrew or you just swapped  
8           primary and backup?

9                    MR. MODI: So, Your Honor, they are -- I  
10          guess I'm quibbling with the terminology. I  
11          guess you would say they probably did withdraw,  
12          Your Honor. I was thinking more that they have  
13          been substituted, if you will. We are new  
14          counsel of record. And if you look at the POAs  
15          that were filed, they actually don't have power  
16          of attorney in these cases to appear in these  
17          cases any longer. So that is the reason I --  
18          you know, I think we were thinking of this as  
19          more a substitution of counsel. But if -- and  
20          that's why we wanted to know if there was  
21          anything additional we needed to do to make sure  
22          the effect -- you know, the change in counsel

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
