JUDGE MITCHELL: Welcome everyone. I should say welcome back.

I am Judge Mitchell. And to my right is Judge Chang. To my left is Judge Chagnon. And appearing remotely are Judges Turner and Stephens.

At this time we would like counsel to introduce yourselves and your colleagues, beginning with Petitioner.

MR. TENNANT: Good afternoon, Your Honors, my name is David Tennant. I am counsel for the GlobalFoundries entities. To my right is Brett Rismiller, also counsel for the GlobalFoundries entities.

We have David McCombs for the Fujitsu entities, Vincent Zhou for Advanced Micro Devices, and John Feldhaus for the Renesas entities. Thank you.

JUDGE MITCHELL: Great. Thank you. And now for Patent Owner?

MR. FAHMI: Good afternoon, Your Honors, Terek Fahmi on behalf of the Patent Owner, Zond.

MR. BARKER: Bruce Barker of Chao Hadidi Stark & Barker, also for the Patent Owner, Zond.

MR. GONSALVES: Gregory Gonsalves, also for Zond.

JUDGE MITCHELL: Thank you. And welcome.

1 We have this afternoon our final hearing in three
2 cases, IPR2014-00861, IPR2014-01088, and IPR2014-01089
3 involving U.S. patent 6,806,652.

4 I would like to say the transcript will be entered in
5 each of the proceedings as we did before and it will be usable
6 for all three cases. And we set forth our procedures for
7 today's hearing in our trial order, but just to remind you of a
8 couple of things, each party will have 90 minutes of total time
9 to present arguments for all three cases.

10 You can certainly allocate your time to each case
11 as you see fit, but if there is something that goes to a
12 particular case, please make sure you identify it in the record,
13 which case you are talking about.

14 Please keep in mind that whatever is projected on
15 the screen won't be viewable by Judges Turner and Stephens,
16 so when you refer to an exhibit on the screen, please state for
17 the record the exhibit and page number for or demonstratives,
18 the slide number to which you are referring.

19 This is certainly also important for clarity in the
20 transcript.

21 And I know you all have done this in the past, but
22 just don't stray from the microphone, so that the court reporter
23 can hear you well, and the Judges.
