Ground F (partial)

Claims 22, 24, and 26-28 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over the Empeg Car User Guide 1999 in view of the Empeg Car Release Notes.

Claim 29 is rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over the Empeg Car

User Guide 1999 in view of the Empeg Car Release Notes, and further in view of Kwon.

Claim 30 is rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over the Empeg Car

User Guide 1999 in view of the Empeg Car Release Notes, and further in view of Osann, Jr.

Claim 25 is rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over the Empeg Car User Guide 1999 in view of the Empeg Car Release Notes, and further in view of Cannon.
