As authorized by the Notice of Filing Date Accorded to the Petition (Paper 4<sup>2</sup>), Paice LLC and The Abell Foundation, Inc. ("Patent Owner") filed a "Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission" (Paper 17, "Mot.") of William Peter Guarnieri.<sup>3</sup> Patent Owner is expected to continue to have registered practitioner as lead counsel.
