Futurewei Technologies, Inc. admits that it is a Delaware Corporation with its principal place of business at 5700 8 Tennyson Parkway, Suite #500, Plano, Texas, 75024, and that it is an indirect subsidiary 9 10 of Shenzhen Huawei Investment and Holding Co., Ltd. Huawei Device USA, Inc. admits that it is a Texas Corporation with principal place of business at 5700 Tennyson Parkway, 12 Suite #600, Plano, Texas 75024, and that it is an indirect subsidiary of Shenzhen Huawei 13 Investment and Holding Co., Ltd. Huawei denies the remaining allegations of Paragraph 2 of the Complaint.

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## JURISDICTION AND VENUE
