DECISION  
Motion to Expunge Document Filed in Error

Patent Owner filed a Motion to Expunge Document Filed in Error. Paper 16. On March 5, 2015, Patent Owner filed, with its Preliminary Response (Paper 15), a copy of Exhibit 2001 bearing the incorrect case number. Paper 16, 2. Patent Owner requests that the erroneous Exhibit 2001 be expunged and replaced with the second Exhibit 2001, also filed on March 5, 2015, which bears the correct case number. *Id.* Patent Owner states that Petitioner's counsel was informed of the error, and was served with a copy of the corrected Exhibit 2001 the same day. *Id.* Petitioner did not file an opposition to Patent Owner's motion.

Given the minor, non-substantive change to the exhibit, and the fact that the replacement exhibit was filed and served on the same day as the incorrect exhibit, we grant Patent Owner's motion. We note, however, that Patent Owner filed a document marked as Exhibit 2001 on February 19, 2015, and therefore the corrected Exhibit 2001 must be re-filed as Exhibit 2002.

## ORDER

It is therefore

ORDERED that Patent Owner's Motion to Expunge Document Filed in Error is *granted*;

FURTHER ORDERED that both copies of Patent Owner's Exhibit 2001, filed on March 5, 2015, shall be *expunged*; and

FURTHER ORDERED that Patent Owner shall file a corrected copy of the second Exhibit 2001 filed on March 5, 2015, marked as Exhibit 2002.
