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
lo·ca·tion noun \lō-'kā-shən\

- : a place or position
- : a place outside a studio where a movie is filmed
- : the act of finding where something or someone is : the act of locating something or someone

 ${f b}$ (1): a tract of land designated for a purpose (2) Australian: FARM, STATION

c: a place outside a motion-picture studio where a picture or part of it is filmed —usually used in the phrase on location

- 2 : the act or process of locating
- $oldsymbol{3}$: the placement of baseball pitches in a particular area of the strike zone; also: the ability to control the placement of pitches

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
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
