Pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 141, 142, and 319 and 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a), Petitioner, Google Inc., hereby appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision entered on June 20, 2016 (Paper 30), and from all underlying orders, decisions, rulings and opinions.

In accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 90.2(a)(3)(ii), Petitioner further indicates that the issues on appeal may include, but are not limited to, the following: (1) the PTAB's construction of "non-exhaustive search"; (2) the PTAB's determination that Petitioner did not demonstrate by a preponderance of the evidence that claims 1, 3-5, 7-8, 21-22, 25, 29, 30, 33, 37, and 38 of the '237 patent were anticipated by the Iwamura reference; (3) the PTAB's determination that Petitioner did not demonstrate by a preponderance of the evidence that claims 1-3, 5-7, 9-11, 13-15, and 21-24 of the '237 patent were anticipated by the Ghias reference; (4) the PTAB's determination that Petitioner did not demonstrate by a preponderance of the evidence that claims 26, 27, 34, and 35 of the '237 patent were obvious over the combination of the Iwamura and Chen references; and (5) any finding or



determination supporting or related to those issues, as well as all other issues decided adversely to Petitioner in any orders, decisions, rulings and/or opinions.
