











FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a telephone set, showing my new design in closed position, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof;

looking from the left in FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is an end elevational view in closed position,

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view in opened position,

the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view in opened position; and

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof in opened position, to a reduced scale.
