Under NetWare 4.x's Directory Services, an element in the directory tree that can contain other containers, leaf objects, or both. The container commonly corresponds to a meaningful level of organization or administration, while the leaf corresponds to a specific network element, such as a user, node or peripheral. Two types of containers commonly used include the Organization and Organization Unit.
