13 A. MY NAME IS NEILL LUEBKE, AND I HAVE BEEN A DENTIST
14 FOR 45 YEARS, AND I HAVE TWO PATENTS IN THIS SUIT.

15 Q. AND WHERE DO YOU LIVE?

16 A. I LIVE IN BROOKFIELD, WISCONSIN, A SMALL TOWN IN
17 WISCONSIN; AND I LIVE THERE WITH MY FRIEND, AND WE'VE BEEN
18 MARRIED 45 YEARS. WE HAVE TWO GROWN CHILDREN, JOHN AND
19 MICHELLE.

20 Q. COULD YOU TELL THE COURT A LITTLE BIT ABOUT YOUR
21 PROFESSIONAL WORK OVER THE YEARS.

22 A. WELL, I'VE BEEN A DENTIST SINCE 1969 AND PRACTICED
23 DENTISTRY AND THEN BECAME AN ENDODONTIST IN 1980 AND
24 BECAME A BOARD CERTIFIED DENTIST IN 1991.

25 Q. AND HOW MANY YEARS HAVE YOU BEEN PRACTICING, DOCTOR,

1 THE COURT: THAT'S ABOUT AS CLOSE AS I'D LIKE
2 TO COME.

3 Q. AND IS THAT A HEAT TREATED FILE OR A NON --
