B. Whether claims 50 and 69 of the '045 Patent are obvious over the combination of Angles, Merriman, HTTP1.0 and Davis.

C. Whether claims 59, 61-63, 72 and 73 of the '045 Patent are obvious over the combination of Angles, Merriman, and HTTP1.0.

D. Any issues identified by Petitioner Google in its Request for Oral Argument.

E. Rebuttal to Google's representation on all matters.

F. Any other outstanding motions and issues that the Board deems necessary for issuing a Final Written Decision.
