Subject: Rocker Chair forward latch

All,

I am attaching pdf file for your review regarding how chair latches onto base.

During our inspection, we noticed potential for placing chair on base without it being secure.

If you do it properly, then there is no problem.

If you do it improperly, then you have potential for chair to sit "on top of" forward latch (not in secure position)

If someone sits on top of unsecure chair, then they could fall backward.

I need you or factory to look into a way to make the chair assemble to base without making customer have to be in very specific position.

We need to allow customer to simply sit chair on top of base, push down a little bit, and then it secures.

The assembly process of chair to base needs to be up and down motion.
