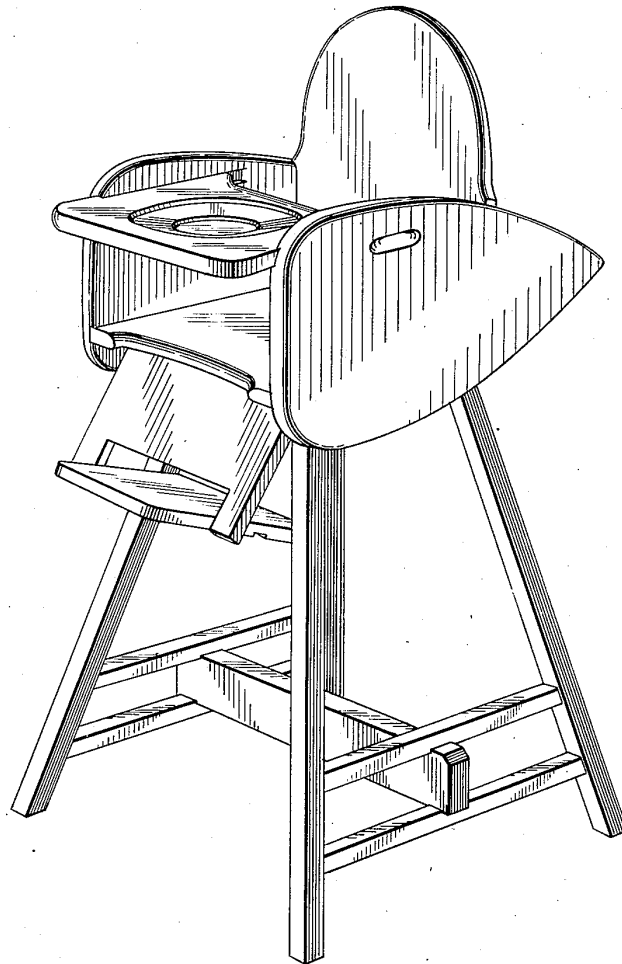

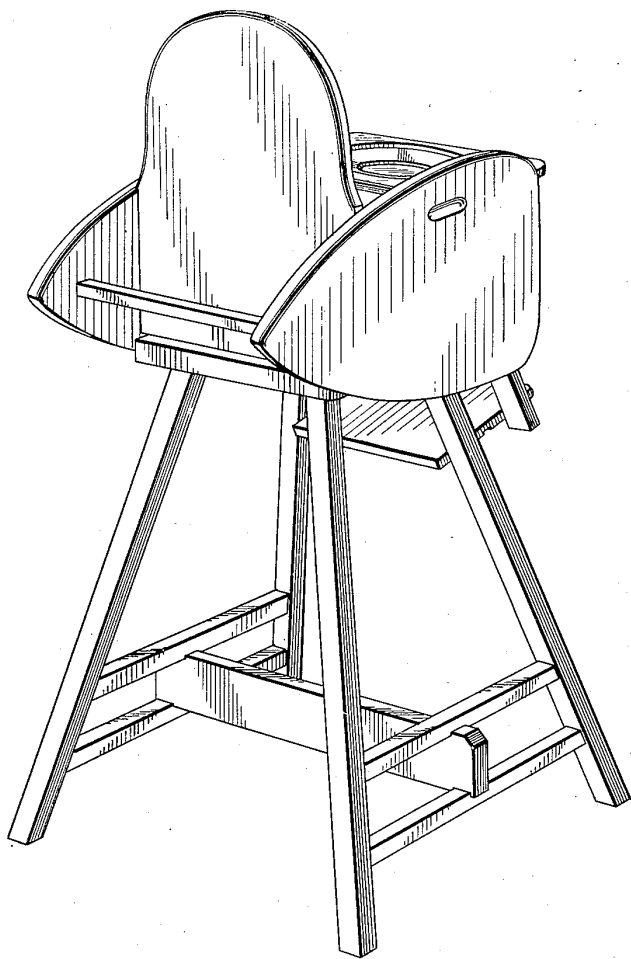

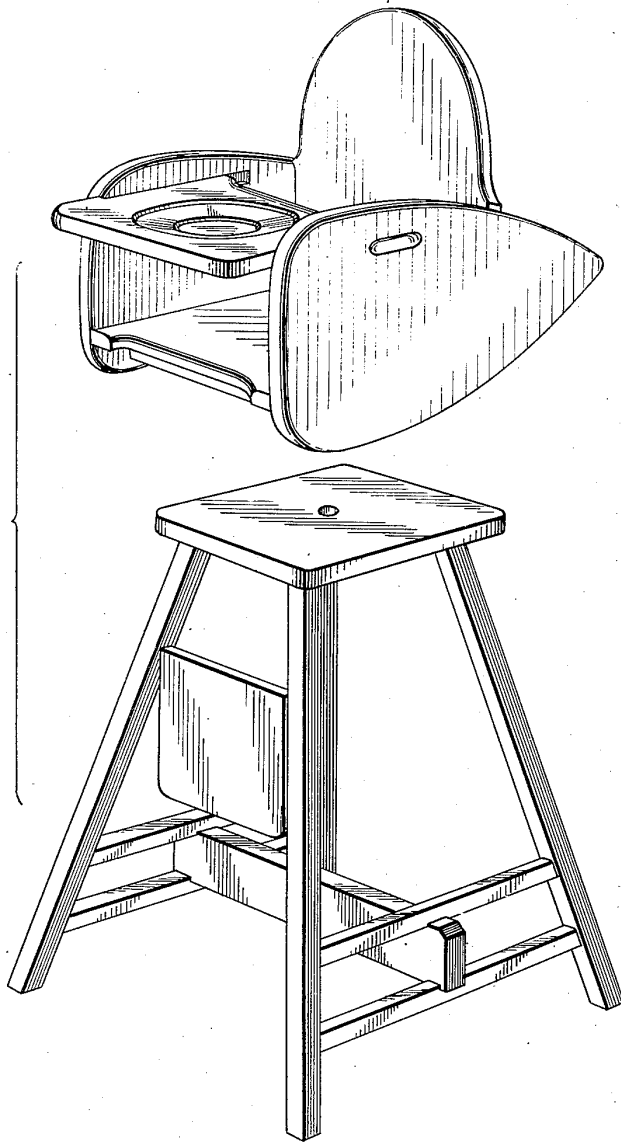

**DESIGN FOR A COMBINATION HIGH CHAIR,
ROCKING CHAIR, AND STOOL**

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Howard C. Wright, a citizen of the United States, residing at Gloucester, in the county of Athens and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combination High Chair, Rocking Chair, and Stool, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a three-quarter front perspective view of a combination high chair, rocking chair and stool, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a three-quarter rear perspective view of the article shown in Figure 1; and

Figure 3 is a three-quarter front perspective view of the article with parts separated to show the rocking chair and the stool.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combination high chair, rocking chair, and stool, as shown and described.
