ERRATA

Errors have been identified in the Decision on Institution of *Inter Partes* Review, issued October 7, 2015 (“Decision”).

On page 2 of the Decision, the citation to the “Rescorla” reference is amended as follows:

E. Rescorla and A. Schiffman, *The Secure HyperText Transfer Protocol*, Internet Draft (Feb. 1996) (Ex. 1004, “Rescorla”).

At page 3 of the Decision, the proposed grounds of unpatentability under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) currently indicated as “Kiuchi and any one of RFC 2660 or RFC 1034” and “Kiuchi, RFC 2660, and RFC 1034” is amended to “Kiuchi and any one of RFC 1034 or Rescorla” and “Kiuchi, RFC 1034, and Rescorla,” respectively.

At page 8, Section D of the Decision, two instances of “RFC 2660” (lines 2 and 3) is amended to “Rescorla.”

At page 11, Section I of the Decision, the parenthetical “[i.e. RFC 2660]” at line 2 of Section I is deleted and the references to “RFC 2660” at lines 8 and 12 of Section I each is amended to “Rescorla.”

At page 12 of the Decision, the reference to “RFC 2660” at lines 2 and 3 is amended to “Rescorla.”

At page 12 of the Decision in the “Conclusion” section, the references to RFC 2660 at lines 3 and 4 of the section are amended to “Rescorla” and in the “Order” section, the reference to RFC 2660 at lines 4 and 5 of the section is amended to “Rescorla.”
